

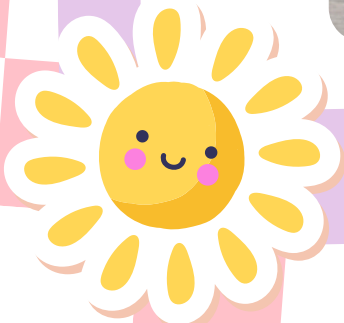
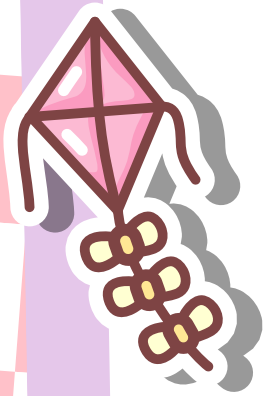

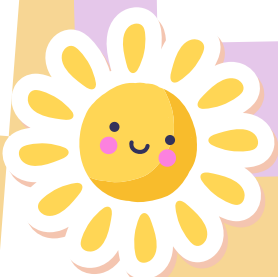
To Our Dedicated Teachers : The Heart of the Classroom

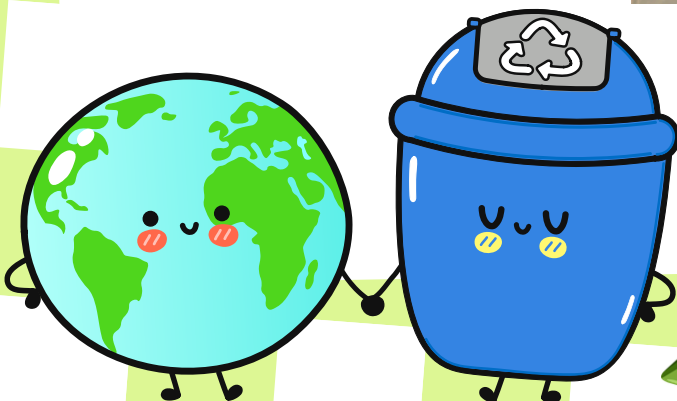

easter

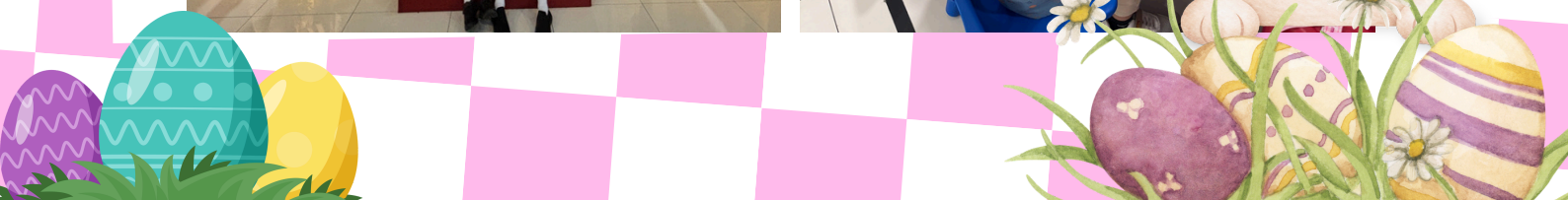

 **Animal Encounters:** Kids met cows and goats, fed tortoises, admired a majestic peacock, and interacted with fluffy Husky dogs.

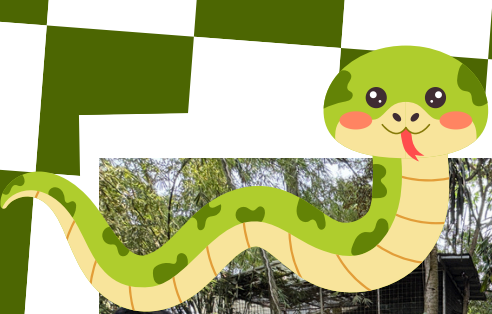
 **Fish Catching:** To end the day, students tested their concentration and hand-eye coordination in a fun, splashing fish-catching activity.

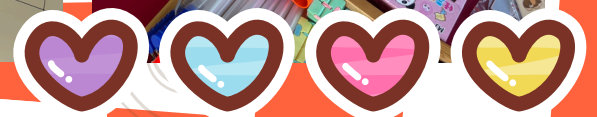

Thank you, parents, for your continued support and partnership in fostering your child's holistic development this year. We look forward to sharing an equally exciting lineup of activities next academic year!





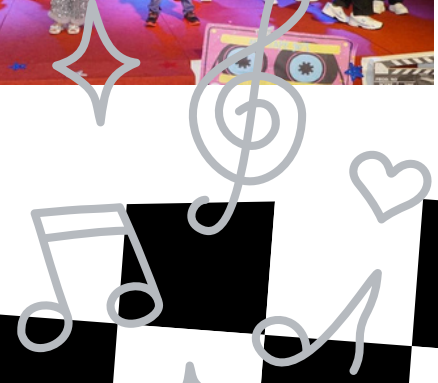
